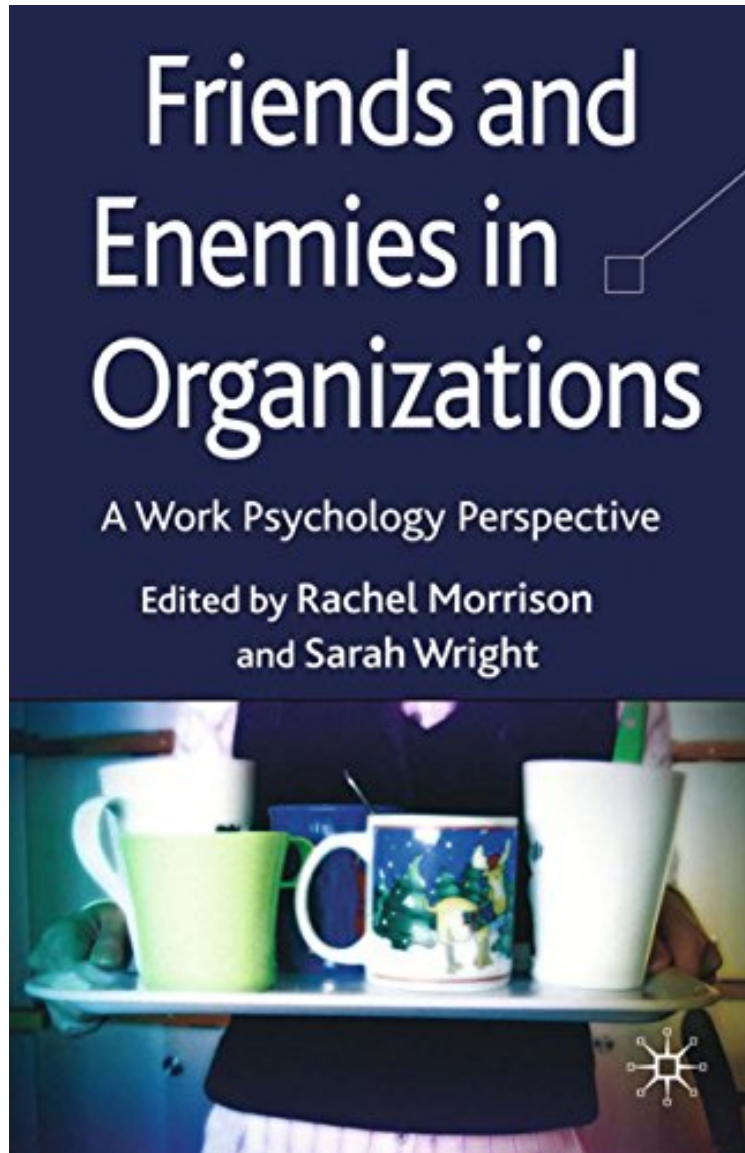

workplace relationships the chapters are very research based and give little advice on how to apply the research to a workplace environment. Also while this book maybe a very good resource for a fellow researcher, it reads very much like a text book which makes it less desirable to a more practitioner based audience that is looking for practical examples and solutions on how to deal with situations like isolation, bullying, aggression and in some cases psychopathic tendencies at work.
