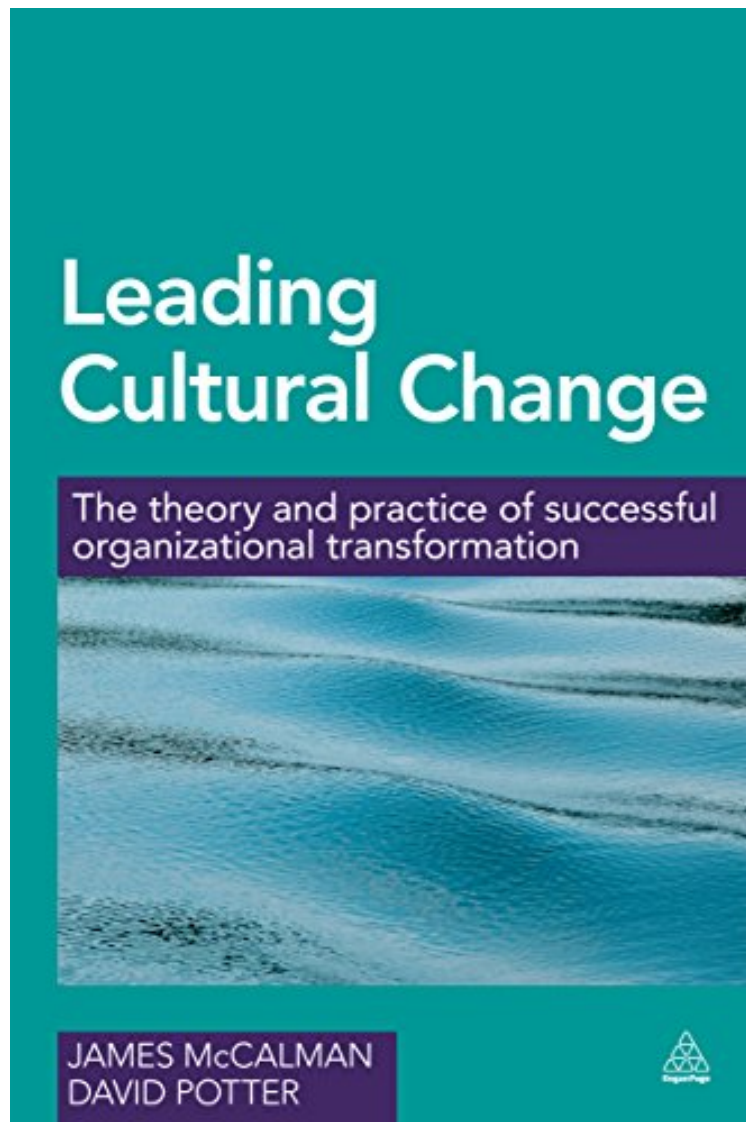

It is not an abstract opus but a practical guide. Here significant and effective theories meet hands on practice. For me, one of the key messages of this book about cultural change is Communication and Commitment.

With coverage of the major theories and concepts alongside diagnostic tools and a practical framework for implementation, *Leading Cultural Change* will help the reader analyse and diagnose their current organizational culture, become aware of the key challenges and how to overcome them and learn how to adapt their leadership style, ensuring they are fit to lead a cultural change programme.
