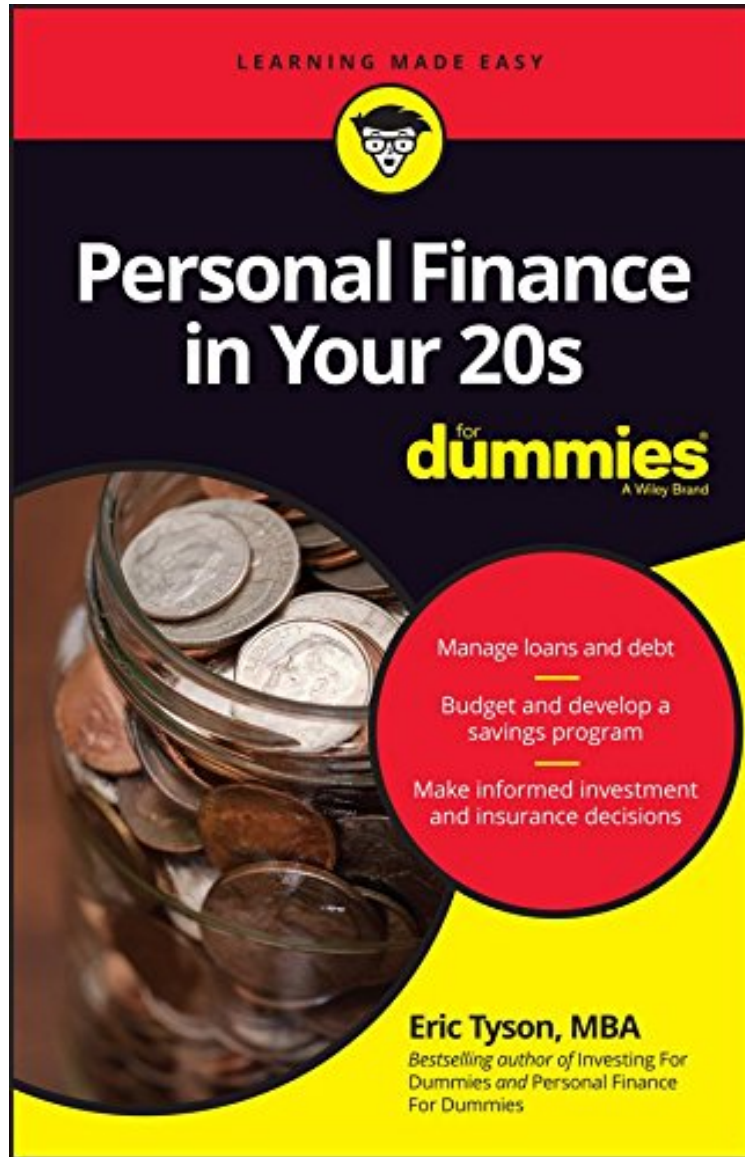

In the book, Tyson explains all of the major aspects of personal financial planning in a way that anyone can understand. I liked the recommendations for good companies to invest with and buy insurance from. As a financial services professional, I concur with most of the recommendations. In general, the advice he provides is very sound and realistic. The two criticisms I have are that he probably goes into a little bit too much detail about investing in small businesses and real estate (in this economy there are very few people in their 20's that can afford or even think about buying high cost stakes in small businesses and rental property, but its clear that those are "hot" topics for the author so he may have been writing in a bit more detail in his personal areas of expertise). Also, I would have liked to see him give some more in depth guidelines for how to save for financial goals when you are in debt.
